#### **B] LIBRARY SERVICES & FACILITIES:**

#### **Library Membership:**

Students, Staff Members, Research Scholars of our college are eligible to use Central Library with Prior Membership. For the library facility reader should be member of the library. We issue at a time three books to each student i.e. One Reference or General book for 15 days & Two Text books for 7 days & Faculty members may issue 3-5 books at a time for 30 days.

#### **Research Reference Section:**

'As we say We Search, You Research', An the Ground Floor of Library Research Reference Section is available for the users with Dictionaries, Encyclopedias, Handbooks, News Papers, Journals, Periodicals & Bound Volumes of the Journals.

#### **Library User Tracking System:**

Libraries measured their success primarily by footfall. For this User Tracking System installed at ground floor & OALS section of the Library.

#### **News Paper Clippings:**

By various subject appendices useful clippings from different newspapers are maintained in files for the students.

#### **Book Bank Facility:**

Library provides Book Bank facility to the needy students. A set of text books are given to the students of the Junior, Senior & P. G. Section of the college per their demand by paying 1/3 of the set amount. For this facility students have to take book bank form from the library & submit it with the Xerox copy of ID card & current year admission Fee Receipt. A set of books are given free of cost to the special students.

#### **BC Book Bank Scheme:**

University of Mumbai provides this scheme for economically backward students (BC) & who belongs to SC/ST/NT/VJNT category. There is a free set of books to FY/SY/TY-B.A. /B.Com/B.Sc. Student's. For this facility Students have to submit Caste Certificate, Income Certificate, Current year Admission Fees Receipt, ID Card Xerox with BC Book-Bank form.

### **Internet Facility:**

A large number of resources are available on the web and students are provided with five computers for internet facilities to access the e-resources, for study & project work. The broad-band internet facility is available in the library for students and faculty. It is free of charge for faculty and students. EBSCO data base is made available at free of charge from Y.C.M.O.U. This Internet Section with gallery of the Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar, and Dr. A. P. J. Abdul Kalam Books has been created for the users.

The SDI Service is given daily to faculty and student by supplying update current affairs, News paper clipping, latest books, etc.

#### **Reference Service:**

The reference books are made available to the readers during library hours for consultation. The personal assistance as guidance and help is provided, if required to the new readers to make use of the reference book.

#### **Library Computerization:**

Our College library is fully computerized Bar-coded. More than one thousand books are available in digital format. The Library uses MKCL's Libraria: Library Management System software developed by MKCL, Pune for library automation. OPAC is provided for searching of documents. The library is having seven terminals for daily routine work and five terminals for internet access. Researchers of library and information science take the benefit of EBSCO database. The work of barcoding is also completed, which helps for effective and speedy transaction of books.

#### Best Reader Award in a year:

To inspire and inculcate the reading habits in the mind of students this award is given on Prize Distribution Day yearly. 'The Best Reader of the Year' award will be given to the student who takes & reads general books & also kept the record of general books reading along with the text books from the library. Total four awards will be given, one from boys and one from girls in the junior as well as Senior Section of the college.

To return books and to save time In pick hours, and when the library is closed, students use this facility.






